

REGULATIONS CORRI TRIESTE 2022 COMPETITIVE ROAD RACE 10 KM

The A.S.D. Promorun Trieste, in collaboration with the Municipality of Trieste and the Friuli Venezia Giulia Region, is organising the 19th edition of Corri Trieste, an athletics road race event included in the FIDAL National Calendar. The event will take place in all weather conditions.

The presence of a doctor and ambulance service will be guaranteed. The organizing company declines all responsibility for any damage to people or things that may occur before, during or after the event. For anything not provided for in these regulations, the FIDAL and G.G.G. federal regulations apply.

By registering for the race, the athlete declares that he has read and fully accepts these regulations.

According to the Fidal Protocol, people can participate on presentation of the COVID-19 green certification (green pass) valid for the day of the race, which must be shown when collecting the bib and at the same time the anti-Covid19 self-declaration can be handed in. If the participant is not in possession of this valid document, it will not be possible to collect the bib and participate in the event.

Please note the procedures for obtaining COVID-19 green certificates:

1. green COVID-19 certification, which can be issued after the administration of the first dose of vaccine and is valid from the 15th day following the date scheduled for the administration of the second dose (in the case of a double dose vaccine). The green certificate shall in any case be valid for nine months after completion of the vaccination cycle;
2. recovery from the Sars-CoV-2 infection (valid for six months);
3. performance of a rapid molecular or antigenic test with a negative result for Sars-CoV-2 (valid for 48 hours). The above provisions do not apply to persons excluded by age from the vaccination campaign and to persons exempt on the basis of appropriate medical certification issued according to the criteria defined in the circular of the Ministry of Health.

START

REGISTRATIONS

Online registration with increasing fees:

from 1st November to 31st January	15,00 €
from 1st February to 31st March	18,00 €
from 1st April to 16th May	20,00 €

Online registration will close at 23:59 on 16 May 2022.

Non pre-registrants

It will be possible to register at the Corri Trieste registration centre at the price of € 25.00 on Friday 20, Saturday 21 and Sunday 22 May:

- The location and times of the registration centre will be announced through social channels and on the official website of the event in the days before the e-wind.

On the day of the race, at the Corri Trieste registration centre in Largo Città di Santos from 7:30 to 8:30, registration is reserved for non-residents of Trieste. Registration without the required documentation (see Participation requirements and privacy form on the website www.corri Trieste.it), or with incomplete contact details and personal data will not be accepted.

THE FEE INCLUDES

- Technical T-shirt
- Event bag
- Medal
- Sponsor products
- Medical assistance
- Timing service with chip to be returned at the end of the race. If the chip is not returned, the athlete must pay € 20 as compensation.
- Refreshments along the route
- Final refreshment

REFUNDS AND TRANSFERS

Participation fees are not refundable and it is not possible to transfer the registration to another athlete.

ATHLETES RESIDING IN ITALY

Based on the provisions of the rules for the organization of events issued by FIDAL, athletes resident in Italy, who have reached the age of 18 at the date of the event (20 years for Runcard members), belonging to the following categories, can participate :

Athletes registered for the current year for FIDAL affiliated clubs.

Athletes in possession of Runcard and a medical certificate of fitness for competitive athletics practice.

The card can be subscribed online on the website www.runcard.com .

Athletes registered with a Sports Promotion Body (Athletics Section) , in possession of Runcard-EPS and a medical certificate of fitness for competitive athletics .

ATHLETES NOT RESIDING IN ITALY

Based on the provisions of the rules for the organization of events issued by FIDAL, athletes who are not resident in Italy who have reached the age of 18 at the date of the event (20 years for Runcard members) can participate, belonging to the following categories:

Athletes with club cards affiliated to Foreign Athletics Federations recognized by the IAAF.

Athletes in possession of Runcard (valid as sports insurance and permission to compete); and a medical certificate of suitability for competitive athletics practice.

The card can be subscribed online on the website runcard.com .

For foreign athletes it is necessary to fill in the "Liability Waiver Form" to be able to participate in the event (to be sent during registration or delivered at the time of bib withdraw) .

BIB AND RACE PACKAGE COLLECTION

At the Corri Trieste registration centre:

- The location and times of the registration centre will be announced through social channels and on the official website of the event in the days before the e-wind.

In order to avoid crowds, the collection of the race pack and the bib on Sunday 22nd May from 7:30 to 8:30 is reserved to athletes not resident in the province of Trieste.

In case of pick up by proxy, the delegating person must fill in, sign and give to the delegate the proxy form, the privacy form, the covid form (downloadable on the website) a copy of the letter of proxy and a copy of the letter of address (which can be downloaded from the website www.corriestrieste.it), a copy of the letter confirming the registration and a copy of his/her identity document.

ROUTE

10 km on the road; completely closed to traffic and flat, from Largo Città di Santos through the Old Port with passage through the area in front of Magazzino 26 and back to Largo Città di Santos to start the second and third laps.



TIME LIMIT

The time limit for completing the 10 km competitive race is 1h30', beyond which the Organising Committee will no longer guarantee control and assistance on the race route.

REFRESHMENTS

As per Fidal regulations, there will be one refreshment point at km 5 and one in the finish area.

TIMING AND CLASSIFICATIONS

The real-time timing and the processing of the rankings are carried out by TDS (Timing Data Service) and are validated by the Technical Delegate Race Judge / Appeal Judge. The classifications will be available online on the TDS website on the event page. The publication of the classifications in the finish area is not foreseen. Complaints shall be lodged no later than 30 minutes after the online publication of the classifications.

INDIVIDUAL AWARDS

Prizes will be awarded to the first 3 absolute male and female athletes and the first 3 of each master category with prizes in kind.

SOCIETY AWARDS

Prizes in kind will be awarded to the first 5 companies classified with a minimum of 15 athletes on the basis of the number of athletes arriving at the finish line, the sum of the athletes arriving at the finish line will determine the final classification.

Unclaimed prizes cannot be claimed again.

ANTI-DOPING SERVICE

Procedures according to FMSI - AIU - WADA indications.

COMPLAINTS

Any complaints must be made in accordance with the FIDAL and R.T.I. regulations.

RIGHTS FOR IMAGE

By registering for Corri Trieste 2021, the athlete authorises the organisation to acquire, free of charge, the right, together with its partners, to use the still or moving images on which he/she may appear, taken during his/her participation in Corri Trieste 2021, on all visual media as well as on promotional and/or advertising materials.

FRAUDULENT PARTICIPATION IN THE RACE – SANCTIONS

The participant is responsible for the ownership and custody of his race bib, acquiring the right to use all the services mentioned in these regulations and subsequent communications.

1. Anyone who takes part in the race without a regular registration number will not only be held responsible for damage to persons or property, including himself, but will also incur sporting sanctions under the jurisdiction of the federal bodies and may be liable to the criminal sanctions provided for the crime of “theft” (art. 624 of the Italian Criminal Code).
2. Anyone who, without regular registration, takes part in the event with a counterfeit bib number or in any case one which does not conform to the allocation, as well as being liable as indicated above, will incur sporting sanctions and, in addition, may be liable to the criminal sanctions provided for the offence of “theft” (art. 624 of the criminal code), or, alternatively, for the offence of “fraud” (art. 640 of the criminal code).

In cases 1 and 2, participants may be liable to the penalties laid down for the offence of “failure to comply with the provisions of the authorities” (Article 650 of the criminal code). The above-mentioned cases will only be found after verification of photographic and/or video documentation.

FINAL WARNINGS

The Organising Committee reserves the right to modify these regulations at any time for reasons it deems appropriate for a better organisation of the race, after having given notice and obtained approval from FIDAL. For anything not provided for in these regulations, the technical statutory regulations of the FIDAL and the G.G.G. apply. Any changes to services, places and times will be communicated to the registered athletes or will be posted on the website www.promorun.it. In addition, the documentation containing the essential information to take part in the race will be delivered by the organisation together with the bib.

ANTI-COVID PROTOCOL

FOREWORD

These regulations have been drawn up in accordance with Federal indications and in compliance with the DPCMs issued in relation to the pandemic emergency. All useful measures will be taken to prevent gatherings and the possible spread of the virus. Given the constant changes in the anti-Covid provisions, these regulations may be subject to change.

The event will take place in the absence of the public.

REGISTRATION

The organisation reserves the right to close registrations early if a maximum number of participants is reached according to the anti-Covid regulations.

RACE NUMBER AND GOODY BAG PICK-UP

At the Corri Trieste registration centre:

- The location and times of the registration centre will be announced through social channels and on the official website of the event in the days preceding the event.

In order to avoid crowds, the collection of the race pack and the bib on Sunday 22nd May from 7:30 to 8:30 is reserved to athletes not resident in the province of Trieste.

In case of pick-up by proxy, the delegating person must fill in, sign and give to the delegate the proxy form, the privacy form, the covid form (downloadable on the website www.corritrieste.it) a copy of the letter confirming the registration and a copy of his/her identity document.

REACHING THE STARTING AREA

All athletes will have their temperature measured before entering the starting grid. Athletes with a temperature of more than 37.5° will not be allowed to take part in the race.

Athletes will be directed to the starting area by the organisers along a mandatory route where a distance of 1 metre from every other athlete must be observed. Signs will indicate the exact position of each athlete.

During the warm up and in the starting area the nose and mouth mask must be worn at all times. Inside the starting area there will be dispensers for hand sanitation.

START

The start will take place in groups of up to 2000 athletes per group, keeping a safe distance. The mask must be worn for the first 500 m of the race and can then be disposed of in special containers. This is the only place where the mask can be thrown away. Athletes caught leaving the mask in other areas of the course will be disqualified. At the end of the race each athlete will be given a new mask. Athletes who wish to do so may continue to run with the mask or take it with them to the finish. Athletes who behave in breach of the health regulations or the instructions of the organisers will be disqualified and asked to leave the area immediately.

COMPETITION BEHAVIOUR

Trail running is strongly discouraged during the race. Athletes are recommended to keep their distance.

REFRESHMENT ON THE ROUTE

As per Fidal regulations, a refreshment point with closed water bottles will be set up along the route at km 5. There will be people in charge of placing the bottles not in contact with the athletes and equipped with personal protective equipment. Athletes must help themselves by taking the bottles provided by the organisation directly on the tables.

ARRIVAL

In the finish area, each athlete will be directed by the staff of the organisation along a route which will facilitate the flow towards a large area which guarantees distance. Each athlete will be given a mask that must be worn immediately and will be invited to leave the area as soon as possible.

FINAL REFRESHMENT

The final refreshment and medal will be given to each participant in a closed take away bag to be consumed outside the finish area.

BAGS DEPOSIT

There is no bag deposit. All athletes are asked to leave their bags in their cars and to arrive at the start area in their race clothing. It is absolutely forbidden to leave any clothing inside the starting area or along the route.

TIMING AND CLASSIFICATIONS

The real-time timing and the processing of the rankings are carried out by TDS (Timing Data Service) and are validated by the Technical Delegate Race Judge / Appeal Judge. The classifications will be available online on the TDS website on the event page. The publication of the classifications in the finish area is not foreseen. Any complaints shall be lodged no later than 30' after the online publication of the classifications.

AWARDS

Podium for the first 3 absolute men and women immediately after arrival. Collection of category and company prizes from 12:00 to 13:00 at the Corri Trieste registration centre:

- The location and times of the registration centre will be announced through social channels and on the official website of the event in the days preceding the event.

RACE CANCELLATION - NON-EXECUTION

If the race is cancelled, moved to another date and/or, in any case, not carried out due to causes that do not depend on and/or cannot be attributed to the will of the organization, including the withdrawal of the authorization to hold the race by the competent public bodies, weather events, earthquakes, epidemics and any other event that may jeopardize the safety of the participants, the participant will not be entitled to claim any reimbursement from the organizing company. Registrations received will be valid for the following year or for another Promorun event. The transfer will be completely free of charge.
